FISHING MUST BE DONE FROM A BOAT

- You must be 18 years and over to enter.
- **FISHING MUST BE DONE FROM A BOAT.**
- Categories – Snapper, Kahawai, Gurnard, Trevally.
- All fishing will be out from Whangamata (one base) – map included.
- The Committee has right of refusal for entries to this competition.
- Weigh Masters and Committees decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
- There must be at least one Clubs NZ Member entered in each team.
- Fish weighed in must have been caught by that angler with a rod/reel on the same day as weighed in **NO LONG LINES!!**
- The Committee reserve the right to disqualify any fish entered that is suspect to the above rule.
- Hours of fishing are 7am to 4pm each day.
- Weigh in at side gate of Club (Philomel Road) between 4pm and 5pm. No weigh in outside these hours!!!
- The Whangamata Club Inc. or its Members take no responsibility for loss or injury during this tournament.
- Registration Friday June 1st between 5.30pm - 7.15pm, briefing at 7.30pm.
- Prize giving will commence at approximately 6pm each night.
- Angler must be present to receive any prize.
- Fish weighed in remain the property and responsibility of the angler.
- The Committee reserve the right to cancel fishing due to weather. If we are fishing the flag opposite the Club on the corner of Port Road and Philomel Road will be UP by 6.30am. But if not sure, please contact Mark 027 531 5540. Prize giving will continue that night even if there has been no fishing done with prizes given away as lucky draws.
- Any angler can only win 1 prize in the Overall section.
